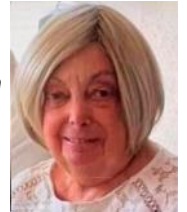


Message from our President — Mary Modica

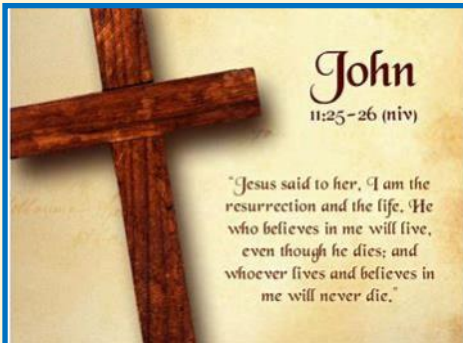

CELEBRATE EASTER—BUONA PASQUA

SUNDAY, APRIL 17, 2022



Easter is celebrated by Christians world-wide as a joyous holiday which represents the fulfillment of the prophecies of the Old Testament and the revelation of God’s salvation plan for all of humankind. Easter is the gift God gave man through the death burial and resurrection of his Son, Jesus Christ. It commemorates and celebrates the belief in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Easter also celebrated the defeat of death and the hope of salvation.

The Easter Bunny has no connection to the Christian religious holiday. Bunnies, eggs, Easter gifts and fluffy yellow chicks all come from pagan roots — a spring holiday, the festival of Eostre, which honored the goddess of fertility and spring. The goddess’s annual symbol was a rabbit, which has long symbolized fertility. The Easter Bunny made its way to America with the German immigrants who brought over their tradition of an egg-laying hair named “Osterhause,” who would lay colorful eggs as gifts to children who were good — evolving into today’s Easter Baskets of ‘goodies!’

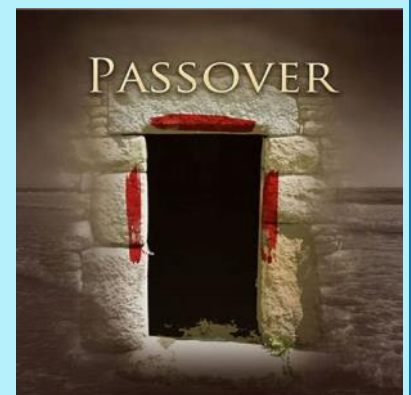


CELEBRATE PASSOVER

Passover (Pesach) commemorates the emancipation of the Israelites from slavery in ancient Egypt. In Hebrew it is known as Pesach (which means to pass over, because God passed over the Jewish homes when killing the Egyptian first born on the very first Passover eve.

**CELLINI LODGE UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP
APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR
HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS - 2022**

CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

To be eligible for an award, a student applying must:

1. Be a child of a **member** in good standing of Cellini Lodge for a period of at least **two-years** prior to submission of an application for a scholarship.
2. Be accepted at an accredited school, college or university or vocational school and express commitment to a degree at a time of presentation.
3. Be given consideration classified with four general categories:
 - a) Cellini Scholar Award (Averages 90% and higher)
 - b) Cellini Scholarship Award (Averages 85% +)
 - c) Cellini Incentive Award
 - d) Vocational and/or Challenge Award
4. Be certain all necessary documents, test scores and letters be submitted by the **DEADLINE** May 7, 2022.

NOTE: Any award is entirely within the discretion of the Scholarship Committee of Cellini Lodge, and may be revoked if:

- a) Any applicant/recipient does not graduate with his/her high school class; and/or
- b) Is unable to submit verification of college acceptance by August 31 of graduation year.

NOTE FOR – Prior 4 Year Gold and Silver Recipients
Recipients must submit verification of college continued enrollment by July 1st of each year for the ensuing year. Failure to comply may result in an award being revoked by the Committee. Any school change must be submitted to Scholarship Committee of Cellini Lodge #2206, OSDIA. An award will be and could be discontinued if a parent member does not remain in good standing. Good standing is defined as paying the annual membership dues by January 1 of each year.

Applicant must be graduated in the year in which scholarship awards are made. Awards are usually made in June of each year. After applicants and parent have completed the information requested, submit to school Principal or Guidance Counselor.

A two-year membership requirement in good standing by a parent must be for two years prior to the date on which the applicant's application for such scholarship is dated, but in no event less than two years prior to May 7, 2022.

In order that the Scholarship applicant might be evaluated properly, the Principal or Guidance Counselor must attach to the application a certified or official high school transcript of the applicant's high school grades with PSAT/SAT ACT scores that might be available through completion of the seventh semester and forward to:

Applications, together with transcript of high school grades through completion of seventh semester and two letters of recommendation must be received by May 7, 2022 of the year of graduation for consideration. If high school grade transcript is missing, the Scholarship Committee has the right to reject the application. “MY ITALIAN BACKGROUND”

I was born to Angela and Alfred Bonvicino. My father, Alfred, the youngest of seven children, was born in Brooklyn, while his six siblings were born in Calabria, Italy. My mother, Angela, the oldest of seven children were all born in Woodhaven, NY along with her six siblings. My maternal grandfather, John Capillo, was born in Calabria, Italy, and my grandmother was born in Manhattan. My paternal grandparents, Aquila and John Bonvicino, were born in Calabria, Italy.

My first husband, Sal Scaturro, was the father of my son, Frank Scaturro, who was a Cellini member until he moved to Hyattsville, Maryland four years ago where he lives with his wife and son. You may remember Frank as a Cellini member and also that he ran for U.S. Congress in the 4th Congressional District three times. His father died in 1994 and several years later, I married Eric, my present husband.

As for me, I've been a member of the American Legion Auxiliary for the past twelve years and for the past several years, I'm the Public Relations Chairperson for Nassau County's American Legion Auxiliary, as well as the Nassau County Sergeant-at-Arms for the Auxiliary. I always appreciate the opportunity to reach out to the community to let them know about the American Legion Auxiliary: who we are, what we do, and why we matter. I'm also Unit Secretary of American Legion Auxiliary—Williston Unit 144.

I'm also a Laughter Wellness Practitioner, founder of “Spinner's Grinners Laughter Yoga Classes” which I conducted at my home studio in NHP for ten years and a few at the Hillside Public Library before COVID hit, and spoke about it on a radio interview at “Project Independence Senior Talk Radio” in January 2020, and then, as we all know, we had the COVID lockdown shortly after that.

I did recently reach out to the Lakeville Estates Civic Association membership to ask the membership to participate in a current Veterans Affairs and Rehabilitation Project that the County's Auxiliary is conducting for 2022: to “adopt a unit” at Northport VA Hospital. As for my husband, (Italian by “our marriage” in 1997), Eric is a U.S. Army veteran, retired educator NYCDOE, and current member of Williston American Legion Post 144. He is a Nassau County's Chaplain for the American Legion, as well as Post Chaplain of Williston Post 144. He is also a member of American Legion Riders who are often seen doing motorcycle escorts out to Calverton Cemetery for fallen members, as well as local drive-bys, to honor vintage veterans celebrating landmark birthdays. He is also Chaplain for United Veterans Organization (UVO) as well as Long Island National Cemetery (LINCNO). He is also an active member of Vietnam War Veterans Association, as well as a dedicated volunteer for Veterans Service Agency. He is also webmaster of “We Are Veterans” website. Suffice it to say, “grass does not grow under his feet.”

As for my Italian/American background: How could I have forgotten to mention the following? My paternal great, great, great, great (many greats) grandfather, name Allesandro Bonvicino, better known as “Il Moretto da Brescia” was a brilliant Renaissance artist (1498-1554) who painted many magnificent religious works of art and was a colleague of Leonardo DaVinci. 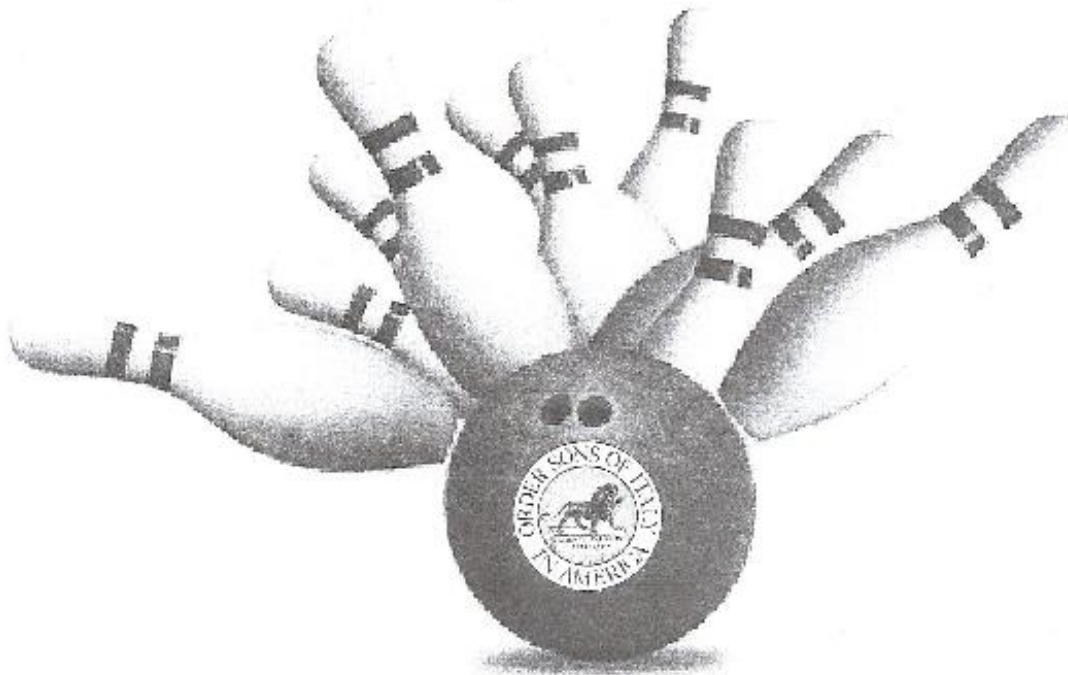

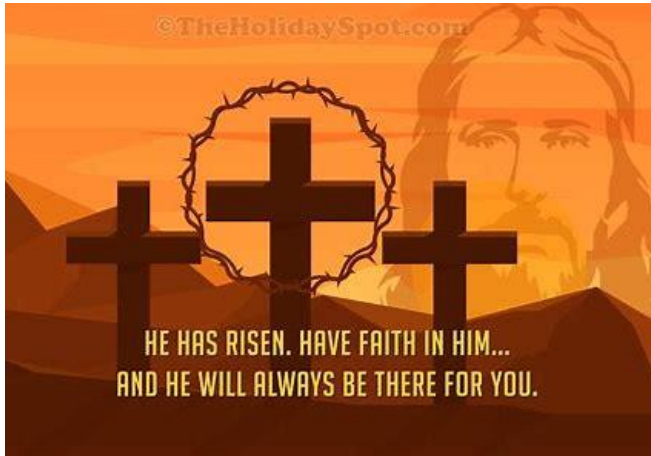
